Prior to law, I studied social work and worked for over two years in northeastern BC as a financial assistance worker with the Province of BC. My background includes senior positions with Indigenous organizations at the Band and Tribal Council levels and with the Assembly of First Nations' national office and Alberta regional office. As VP of a new division of Legal Aid BC, I was responsible for Indigenous services and initiatives including the successful expansion of seven new Parents Legal Centres. From the spring of 2020 to the end of 2022, I worked with the BC First Nations Justice Council as Provincial Director, Indigenous Justice Centres and Director, Legal Aid Services respectively.
